I maintain contact with the parties and try to get settlement, which sometimes happens weeks or months later.

I served as "slot man" on the city desk. The city desk is shaped like a horseshoe. The slot man sits in the slots. Other editors sit on the periphery. The slot man coordinates work of the other editors and is in charge of Page 1 and two or three inside pages.

Prior to working at the Lima News, I worked for the Wichita, Kansas, Beacon; and the Fort Worth Star-Telegram.

After my stint at the Lima News I owned and operated the Throckmorton, Texas, Tribune and the Springtown, Texas, Review. I owned and operated Arlington Printing and Duplicating, which I sold when I entered seminary. While a seminary student, I served as editor and publisher of the Richardson, Texas, Digest, and served as founding pastor of Trinity Baptist Church in Richardson.

After graduating from seminary and still pastoring the church in Richardson, I served as public relations director for Texas Alcohol Narcotics Education, a church supported organization. I resigned the church in Richardson and entered full time evangelism ministry.

During the next four years, in addition to preaching and teaching, I managed special election campaigns in Texas, Arkansas, and New Mexico. Of 13 major campaigns we won 11.

Then I went to the First Baptist Church in Fate, Rockwall County, Texas, where I served as pastor for 13 years. After that, I was founding pastor of the Princeton Park Baptist Church in Rowlett, Texas, for 9 years. After retirement from the pastoral ministry, I began training as a mediator.
