Dr. Sarah Shelton is a Licensed Clinical Forensic & Medical Psychologist in Kentucky and Illinois with practices in Paducah, Louisville, and Lexington, KY. She also travels to other cities and states in a forensic capacity. She provides evaluation, assessment, mediation, and Expert Witness Testimony in family, civil, criminal, and juvenile court cases and provides psycho-legal consultation to attorneys. She earned a Masters Degree in Clinical Psychology (Murray State University) and a Doctorate in Clinical Psychology (Spalding University). She was Chief Intern at the Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine prior to completing two Postdoctoral Fellowships in Health Psychology and Behavioral Medicine at the Medical College of Georgia, where she later became faculty in the Department of Pediatrics and Psychiatry and earned a Master of Public Health Degree. She also completed training in Applied Forensics (Chicago School of Professional Psychology) and earned a Postdoctoral Master of Science Degree in Psychopharmacology (Fairleigh Dickinson University). In addition to her clinical practice, Dr. Shelton is faculty in graduate programs at Spalding University (Doctor of Psychology), the University of the Cumberlands (Doctor of Psychology & Master of Justice Administration) and The Chicago School of Professional Psychology (Psychology, Public Health, & Postdoctoral Psychopharmacology). She is a lecturer, author, and is frequently interviewed in popular media. Dr. Shelton has held several elected and appointed leadership positions at the state and national level. She is President-Elect of the Kentucky Psychological Association; an Approved Supervisor and Oral Examiner for the Kentucky Board of Examiners in Psychology; is serving her second elected four-year term on the Board of Directors of the National Register for Health Service Psychologists; and holds a committee appointment for APA's Division 41 American Psychology-Law Society.
