From 1995 to late 2013, while Jay maintained his private law practice, he also presided as a Hearing Examiner for the City of New Orleans Civil Service Commission where he heard disciplinary appeals of city employees; rendered administrative opinions; represented the Commission in civil litigation; and rendered legal advice and recommendations to the Commission upon request. Jay resumed his Hearing Examiner duties in early 2017.

From 2007 to 2013 Jay also served as General Counsel to the Louisiana Recovery School District (RSD). Jay stepped into the role as General Counsel following Hurricane Katrina in early 2007. He built the RSD legal services department from scratch, oversaw all of its construction-related matters, employment issues, contracts, legal cost management, outsourcing of legal matters and oversight of the RSD's compliance with federal and state regulations.

In the early 1980s and from 1990 through 1994, Jay served as an Assistant City Attorney representing the City of New Orleans in class action and civil rights litigation. In addition, Jay worked in Hollywood as an Executive Assistant to the Executive Director of the American Federation of Television and Radio Artists. In that role, he negotiated and interpreted collective bargaining agreements; handled contract grievance/arbitration matters; and assisted with other various legal matters.

Early in his career Jay worked as a Field Attorney for the National Labor Relations Board where he conducted investigations; litigated cases involving unfair labor practice charges; represented petitioners; challenged ballots and election objections; and conducted union certification elections.
