A substantial time element of this period was spent in developing computer analysis methods for extracting the most relevant information from the immense quantity of data derived from the experiments.

Taught undergraduate physics courses and assisted in the development of new laboratory series.

As a member of this Iowa State University research facility, I collaborated on designing experiments which took several years to build and take data at the Fermilab National Accelerator Center near Chicago.

Taught undergraduate physics courses, including a new series of laboratory courses.

Engaged in high energy particle experiments and associated analysis. Lived for a semester at CERN in Geneva Switzerland to set up and take data in a new experiment there related to exploration of further details of quarks and particle structure.
